

The first sign

Jesus' first miracle was at a wedding. The miracle was not simply a demonstration of Jesus' power. It was in response to the intercession of his mother on behalf of an embarrassed couple. More than that, in Scripture, a wedding was an image of God's covenant with Israel, and the abundance of wine suggested the beginning of the age of the Messiah. The new wine is the best, perhaps too a prelude to the pouring out of Jesus' blood in his act of salvation.
